General

Thailand Golf Association (TGA) is pleased to forward the following details in preparation for the Championship in Thailand.

1. Championship Dates & Venue

The SINGHA Thailand Junior World Golf Championships 2024 will be held from Thursday, Oct 31 to Sunday, Nov 3, 2024 at Royal Hua Hin Golf Course is the oldest golf course in Thailand. The 18 holes Championship course measures 6,678 yard and has a par of 72 in over 240 acers of trees.

3. Meals

Breakfast will be provided for players and officials by the championship committee free of charges at the

official hotel between 6 a.m. to 10 a.m. Lunch will be served at Royal Hua Hin Golf Course (free of charge

for players and participants). Dinner will be served at Royal Hua Hin Golf Course and Hua Hin Grand Hotel

and Plaza at participant's own expense. Snack & Drink shops are located at the golf course.

Complimentary drinking water and fruits will be available at tee-off hole 1 & 10.

4. Airport Arrivals

All players and officials will arrive at Suvarnabhumi International Airport which is approximately three and

a half hours drive to the official hotel. The Transportation from Airport to the Hotel will be provided from

Suvarnabhumi Airport only. TGA staff will welcome teams and supporters upon arrival with a signage

"SINGHA Thailand Junior World 2024" @ entrance no.1 arrival hall (level 2) Our transportation will start

on October 29, 2024 for early arriving 6,000 baht per van will be charge. One van can take maximum 6

people. To facilitate your reception, each team is kindly requested to advise your arrival/ departure dates by

October 16, 2024.

5. Internal Transportation

Daily transportation will be available between the Official Hotel and the Golf Course. The van schedule will

be announced at the hotel and golf course. Royal Hua Hin Golf Course approximately 10-15 minutes from

official hotel.

6. Green Fee, Caddie & Cart Fee

House caddie will be assigned to each player during practice and championship rounds. All players must use

the caddies provided by TGA and player may not use his own caddie nor carry his own bag.

TGA will cover the green fee & caddie fee on official practice round and championship rounds.

The cart fee is 700 THB per round (only cash is acceptable/participant's own expense)

Note: All Players must pay for the caddie tip at the registration 500 Baht per round

7. Registration

All teams should register at their earliest convenience upon arriving. Championship office is located in Hua

Hin Grand Hotel and Plaza, and will be operational from Tuesday, 29 October 2024 09.00 am – 05.00 pm Player arriving late MUST inform TGA by email in advance and late registration may cause that player disqualify.

Only on Practice round, October 30, 2024 all players must register and obtain scorecards and caddie coupons at the tournament office (Golf Course) before your practice time.

On October 31 – November 3, 2024 players not need to come to the tournament office, but should arrive at the tee-off point at least 15 minutes before your starting time.

During the championship period, the tournament office (Golf Course) will be open one hour before play and close one hour after the end of play.

8. Entry Fee

The entry fee is waived for 2 nominated players from national golf association (1 boy and 1 girl). The entry fee for additional player is USD 500 per player cash only (Include accommodation, Breakfast, Lunch and Green fee and caddy fee).

9. Entry Deadline

The Entry form is to be sent by <u>4 pm, Monday, September 30, 2024</u> to Thailand Golf Association with the latest player's Bio-data Forms.

10. Driving Range

The driving range opens daily from 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on practice days and the tournament days. Range balls are free of charge.

11. Locker Room

Lockers are available for <u>players</u>, <u>captains</u> and <u>delegates</u> during the championship date. Shower & bath facilities will be available for everyone.

12. Dress Code

We recommend that team members are attired neatly at the Opening and Closing Ceremonies.

13. Welcome Party and Farewell Dinner

Welcome party and Farewell Dinner for all participants will be held at Royal Hua Hin Golf Course.

All participants are advised to check if they require a visa for entry into Thailand.

16. Voltage

In Thailand, electricity voltage is 220 volt AC. and our plugs have 2 round pins. For visitors bringing 110

volt appliances, it is advisable to bring a small 110 volt transformer and a plug conversion kit.

email every day.

CONDITIONS OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

1. Eligibility

The Championship is open to all junior golfers in all countries, who have not reached their 19th birthday on the first day of the championship (who are not yet 19 as of October 31, 2024) and who:

- a) Must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status as laid down by the R&A Rules Limited; and
- b) Have a WHS Handicap Index or USGA handicap index or other handicaps accepted by the COMMITTEE. Participants are requested to attach their birth certificate together with their entry.

2. Format

- 72 holes stroke play for Boys and Girls Class A and Class B.
- 54 holes stroke play Boys and Girls Class C and Class D.

3. Individual Competition

Competition will be conducted over the following age groups:

Class	Age Group	Boys' Handicap Limit	Girls' Handicap Limit
A	15 to 18 years	12 or below	18 or below
В	13 to 14 years	16 or below	20 or below
C	11 to 12 years	24 or below	30 or below
D	10 years & under	30 or below	36 or below

3.1 Individual: Class A and B

While the team competition is being held, and individual tournament will also take place. The competition will be stroke play over 72 holes, 18 holes a day, for four consecutive days of the event. The winner of the individual event shall be the player obtaining the lowest aggregate scores of the 4 rounds.

3.2 Individual: Class C and D

The competition will be stroke play over 54 holes, 18 holes a day, for three consecutive days of the event. The winner of the individual event shall be the player obtaining the lowest aggregate scores of the 3 rounds.

4. Team Competition

There will be international team events for both the boys and girls sections:

Team members for the Boys' event shall comprise of 2 players:

- 1 x Class A and 1 x Class B players or
- 2 x Class B players or
- 2 x Class A players are allowed.

Team members for the Girl's event shall comprise of 2 players:

- 1 x Class A and 1 x Class B players or
- 2 x Class B players or
- 2 x Class A players are allowed.

The competition will be stroke play over 72 holes, 18 holes a day, for four consecutive days of the event.

All players in each team are to play four (4) rounds.

Participants are requested to attach their birth certificate together with their entry.

Team members shall be named before the start of the championship to the COMMITTEE on captains meeting on October 25, 2023. The time and venue of the meeting will be announced subsequently.

5. Rules of Golf

The SINGHA Thailand Junior World Golf Championships 2023 will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A and any Local Rules as approved by the Championship Committee.

7. Scoring

The team's score for each round shall be obtained by adding two (2) player's scores in each team. The score counting for the competition shall be the total team's scores for the four (4) rounds. The winning trophy will be awarded to the team with the lowest scores for the 72 holes.

8. Decision on Tie

In the event of a tie for the Championship, the winning team shall be decided by a hole by hole sudden death play-off, with the best scores of each team at each hole counting. The play-off shall decide the winner only.

8.1 Ties for Individual Placing

In the event of a tie for the first place, a "sudden death play-off" hole by hole will be held until the winner is decided. In the event of a tie for any individual placing, the tie shall be decided by a count back in the following

order:

- The best score of the 18 holes (1-18) of the final round. If still tie,
- The best score of the last nine holes (10-18) of the final round. If still tie,
- The best score of the last six holes (13-18) of the final round. If still tie,
- The best score of the last three holes (16-18) of the final round. If still tie,
- Hole by hole count back (Final round) will decide the winner,

If there is still no result then the winner shall be decided by the toss of a coin, or according to the COMMITTEE and TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR officially announce.

8.2 Ties for Team Competition

i. In the event of a tie or ties for the first place in Team Competition, the players in the teams tying shall as soon as possible continue to play-off hole by hole until the winner is decided. The play-off holes

will be decided by the Tournament Director.

ii. In the event that there are more than 2 teams tying, the first team/teams to lose the hole by hole play-off shall discontinue play. This play-off is to determine the winner of Team Competition only.

iii. In the event of a tie for any team placing, the tie shall be decided by a count back in the following order:

- The best team score of the 18 holes (1-18) of the final round. If still tie,
- The best team score of the last nine holes (10-18) of the final round. If still tie,
- The best team score of the last six holes (13-18) of the final round. If still tie,
- The best team score of the last three holes (16-18) of the final round. If still tie,
- The best team score hole by hole count back (Final round) will decide the winner,

If there is still no result then the winner shall be decided by the toss of a coin, or according to the COMMITTEE and TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR officially announce.

9. Close of Competition

The competition is deemed to be closed when the Championship trophy has been presented to the winning team and individual at the closing ceremony.

Disqualifying Players After Result of Match or Competition Is Final see Rules 20.2e

10. Caddies

Teams must use house caddies provided by the host country. Caddies will be assigned to teams and players on a random basis. Player may not use his own caddie nor carry own bag.

11. Transportation

Players must not ride on any form of transportation during a stipulated round unless authorized by the Committee.

12. List of Conforming Golf Balls & Driving Club

List of Conforming Driver Heads: Model Local Rule G-1 is in effect. Penalty for making a stroke with a club in breach of Local Rule: Disqualification.

List of Conforming Golf Balls: Model Local Rule G-3 is in effect. Penalty for breach of the Local Rule: Disqualification.

Note: an updated List of Conforming Clubs and Balls is available on www.randa.org

13. Unbecoming Conduct

The Committee may impose a penalty of disqualification for improper conduct such as swearing and throwing of golf clubs.

14. Recording of Scores

Each player will be assigned as "marker" (see Rule 3.3b(2)) to record the score of another player in the same group. The marker shall be responsible for recording the player's correct score after each hole. After completion of the round the player shall:

- Check his/ her hole-by-hole score for accuracy. Settle any doubtful points with the Committee.
- Ensure that his/ her marker has signed his/ her card. Countersign the card him/ herself

15. Time of Starting

If the players arrive at their starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after their starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is loss of the first hole in match play or two strokes at the first hole in stroke play. Otherwise, the penalty for breach of this Rule is disqualification. See Rule 5.3a.

16. Pace of Play

Rule 5.6b will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

17. Suspension of Play; Resumption of Play

Suspension of Play (Rule 5.7) The following signals will be used to suspend and resume play:

- immediate stop for imminent danger one prolonged note of a siren;
- stop for a non-dangerous situation three consecutive notes of a siren;
- resumption of play two consecutive notes of a siren.

Note: when play is stopped for imminent danger, all practice areas will be immediately closed.

18. Disqualification Penalties

A penalty of disqualification for a breach of the Rules or the Conditions for the Championship applies to the stipulated round where the breach occurred.

19. Prize

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

Team Competition

Boys' Team Best 3 teams

Girls' Team Best 3 teams

• Individual Competition

Individual Boys 5 best gross scores of Class A, B, C and D.

Individual Girls 5 best gross scores of Class A, B, C and D.

Daily Medal Best daily gross score class A, B, C and D.

● Overall Class A, B – 72 holes

Class C, D - 54 holes

Note: The player can receive only Overall prize when there are Individual Prize and Overall Prize in the same player.

20. Championship Result

During the Championship, Thailand Golf Association will email official championship result to each organization every day. Result will be offered at club house, Royal Hua HIn Golf Course.

21. Result of the Competition

When the final results sheet is placed on the official notice board, the result of the competition is deemed to have been officially announced.

22. Disputes and doubtful points

Any disputes or doubtful points must be referred to the Tournament Committee within 15 minutes after completion of each round.
